The abstracts of those proposals which are accepted will be made available on the FCMU Web site, and will be distributed in a booklet at the conference.

Poster topics should pertain to (1) cost, quality, and access to health care, especially with regard to vulnerable populations; (2) public health and prevention within vulnerable populations; (3) innovative health policies at the local and/or state level; or (4) other topics relevant to health care and Medicaid in Florida, including health disparities and cultural competency.

Poster Contest: A panel of judges from the Florida Center for Medicaid and the Uninsured and the Florida Agency for Health Care Administration will select a poster to receive recognition as "6th Annual Florida Medicaid Research and Policy Conference Best Poster."
