Organization

- Voter approved in 1988
- Legislature enacted in 1989
- Board Appointed by Governor and County Commission
- Independent authority to levy taxes
- Serves over 300,000 residents annually

- Universal maternity coverage
- Enrollment through community partners
- Over 1,700 women cared for
- Up to 10 months of free coverage for prenatal and postnatal care

Personal Health Plan

- Provides Medicaid Health Maintenance Organization (HMO) benefits
- Over 7,000 children and families served annually
- Accredited by Accreditation Association for Ambulatory Health Care Inc.
- Medical case management
- Licensed through State of Florida





- Affordable premiums subsidized by the Health Care District
- Monthly premiums range from \$25 to less than \$100 per individual
- Tiered co-payments based on income range from \$5 (physician visits) to \$30 (inpatient hospital services)
- For Palm Beach County residents ages 1 to 65 who have been without health coverage for six months
- Individuals earning less than \$17,150 per year or a family of four earning less than \$35,000 are eligible
